BELLINGHAM, Wash., April 1.—Holding that advertising is not soliciting and that the local option statute being a criminal law, must be interpreted strictly and not broadly.

Judge John A. Kellogg of the superior court this morning sustained the defendant's demurrer to the information against J. Aronson, wholesale liquor dealer of Seattle, who was charged with a violation of the liquor law because he advertised his liquors in the public press in Bellingham, which is a dry unit. The case will be appealed by the state.
