Medford sportsmen have declared war on the crows and have determined to exterminate these destroyers of game birds as quickly as possible. Since last January over 700 crows have died and the war is being waged with skill on both sides,

The crows have changed their rook eries and feeding grounds and now all are congregating at or near the Gold Ray dam. For miles they come each evening and hunters say that he sky is black with them at dusk

it takes all the skill possible to kill them. They fly high to the dam and then drop quickly into the brush and a gunsman needs to be quick of eye and finger. Not only that, but the crows are "wise" to crow decoys, and "crow callers," and only live decoys will attract them.
