

FEW APPLES IN MARKET

Exports and Supply in Storage Show Marked Diminution—Market Generally Stronger and Consumption Heavy—Few Box Apples Left.

Scobel & Day issue the following under date of New York, April 1—Liverpool as per cable from L. Connolly & Co. shows a still higher market as follows:

Newtowns-Watsonville, 4-tier, 8.6 to 10.9, according to condition.

Newtowns-Watsonville, 4 1/2-tier, 8.6 to 10 according to condition.

Reds-Washington, 9-6 to 9-9, according to condition.

Ben Davis-Washington, 8 to 8-6 according to condition.

They say the market continues very strong with a good demand.

Again this is a reduction of 5000 boxes from the shipments of the week previous and of course the markets abroad will continue to advance.

Sales at auction here since our last have been very small. One car of California Missouri Pippins, 4 1/2 tier all at \$1.65. One car Watsonville Newtowns, 4 tier, oldish and a bit ripe, at \$1.50 to \$1.55. At private sale one car of handsome apples from the Yakima section sold: Winesaps \$2.40 to \$2.50, Arkansas Blacks handsome, \$2.45, and Rome variety, large, \$2.25 to \$2.30. Several cars of low grade apples that had been kept too long and showed it, sold from \$1.50 to \$1.75. Market generally is stronger and the consumption heavy so that in another month there will not be many box apples left here.
