

VALLEY CHARMS EAST OREGONIAN

Former State Senator McAllister of Union County Making His First Visit to Southern Oregon—Predicts Emigration Here From East.

"I am much pleased with the Rogue River valley, and Medford is a fine little city," said ex-Senator D. A. McAllister of Union county, Oregon. "My wife and I have been to California and on our way home to La Grande we decided to stay over in Medford and visit friends and see the country.

"I think there are great chances in this valley for development work and once the water power is chained the valley should be a hive of industry.

"Your land is high, compared to eastern Oregon, and I am not used to the prices of \$200 to \$1200 per acre.

"A good many people are selling out in Union and Willowa counties and all the trend of immigration is to southern Oregon. I have many views of the valley that I intend to show the people back there when I talk of this section.

"It's a funny thing that I never was in this section of the state before, yet I came across the plains in 1862 with ox teams and have lived here ever since.

"I was state senator twice, once having the title of the "lone democratic senator from Union and Willowa counties."

I served in the house with Carter of Ashland and Holt from this section.

"For 12 years I was on the state fair board, so I met many people from here."

LAND OWNERS GIVE BUT LITTLE

Ashland Commercial Club Finds That Those Benefited Least by Publicity Work Give the Most—Real Estate Speculators Shy in Donations.

ASHLAND, Or., April 7.—Judge E. D. Briggs of the Ashland Commercial club reports that the publicity committee has succeeded in raising \$5000 for publicity work during the coming year. His report, which censures realty owners, is as follows:

"The business men of the city of Ashland responded nobly, with but very few exceptions, and we are pleased to announce that we have filed with the secretary of said Commercial club a subscription list amounting to \$5020.80, none of the subscriptions being based upon any contingency, and we believe that all will be paid.

There is embraced in the subscription \$2799.30 of the subscription fund of 1910, and we were required to raise, and did raise \$2221.50 of new subscriptions.

"That, of the fund of \$5020.80 the business men of Ashland subscribed \$3380; other residents of the city subscribed \$320.50; parties outside the city subscribed \$35; miscellaneous sources, such as Civic Improvement club and the like—\$85.20; the Warren Construction company, \$600; the council of the city of Ashland, \$500.

"You will note from this that those who are the least benefited and in fact are more or less injured have practically subscribed seven-tenths of the fund, while those people having real estate for sale and who would be the most benefited through publicity work, have subscribed about one-seventeenth of the fund.

"The Ashland Commercial club has been the means of making thousands of dollars for people owning real estate in proximity to the city and within the city, and who have practically done nothing to reimburse the Commercial club for the money expended in their behalf.

"We trust and hope that these peo-

ple, who have reaped a great benefit from the energies and efforts of the Commercial club, will feel hereafter a moral obligation to give the club loyal support, as the club needs their assistance in order that the good work may go on."
