

BRIDGE OVER ROGUE IN USE

Locomotive for First Time Crosses Span of New Railroad Being Built Out of Grants Pass Toward Applegate.

At 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon the locomotive of the Grants Pass & Rogue River railroad, crowded with citizens and officials of Grants Pass, made its first trip across the long bridge, just completed over Rogue river.

Construction work to the south will now move rapidly as a result of the opening for trains by the long bridge, which measures 735 feet.

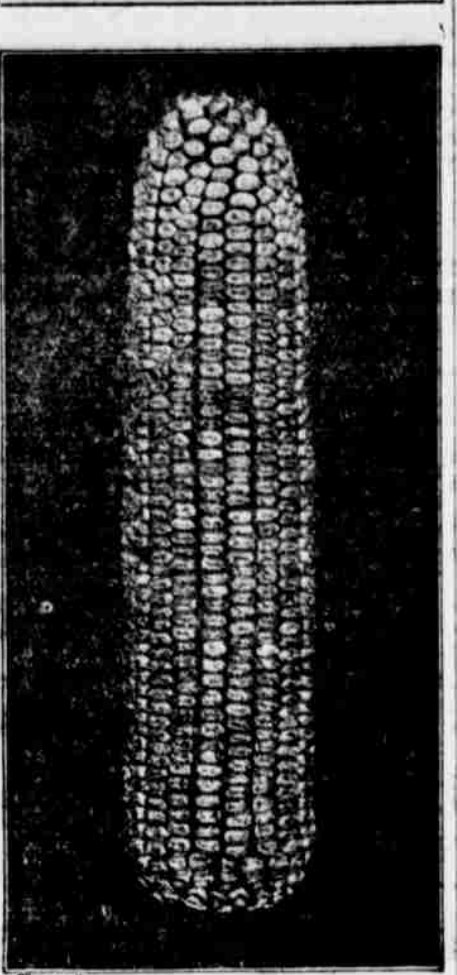
