"This week," he said, "we have wit-nessed a public protest against the de-cision of the highest court in the land. The statute they considered makes no strict reference to reasonable or unrea-sonable restraints upon trade. Numer-ous attempts to amend that statute by including the word unreasonable have repeatedly failed. I rejoice that we have one member of that court who opposed his fellows with the assertion that the judiciary should not attempt to legis-late but only to pass decision upon what legislative arm of the government
