

CATTLE MARKET DROPS 50 PER CENT

PORTLAND, May 29.—Receipts for the week have been 2284 cattle, 49 calves, 1846 hogs, 4883 sheep.

The cattle market is about 50c lower than last week. A number of the sellers make the claim that the market is 60c to 70c lower, but there has been a difference in the quality of the cattle.

The hog market has been steady to higher. One smooch lot weighing 192 pounds, brought \$6.75.

The sheep market has been steady throughout with a ready taking of anything that has been offered.

The horse market has been active.

The establishment of a cattle loan company, with headquarters at Portland Union Stock Yards is the most important happening in livestock circles within two years.
