TROOPS LEAVE LONDON: CORONATION IS FINISHED

LONDON, June 29.—Sixty thousand troops evacuated the city today after having taken part in the "military occupation" of London during the coronation festivities. The infantrymen have left, and only a portion of the cavalrymen remain. For the visit of the king and queen to London tomorrow troops will be drafted from the garrisons nearest the metropolis.
