

PETERSON IS TO BE RELEASED

Fourth Suspect Is Now Thought Innocent—Finger Prints Last Hope of Authorities to Connect Man With Crime.

OLYMPIA, Wash., July 17.—Swan Peterson, fourth suspect arrested for the Coble murder at Hainier a week ago may be released like his predecessors, for lack of evidence to hold him.

It is agreed by the authorities today that the last hope of connecting Peterson with the crime lies with the Cathy Brothers of Portland who are taking thumb prints of Peterson to-day and comparing them with prints found at the Coble home.

Before leaving Portland last night for Olympia, C. F. Cathy admitted that the finger prints secured at the Coble home were imperfect and he feared would not be conclusive in pointing to Peterson's guilt or innocence.

In the meantime Peterson maintains his previous attitude of simple minded innocence. Confronted with the scene of the crime Saturday night he exclaimed, "Oh, I could not do such a thing. I would kill myself right away."

Sheriff Gaston is all but convinced of Peterson's innocence, and is on the trail now of a fifth suspect. Tacoma police have been asked to assist in the pursuit of the new suspected man.

Peterson said today that at the time of the Hill murder in Portland, which he is also questioned about, that he was 300 miles south of Portland at the time, having come across the California border.
