That section 1 of ordinance No. 476, entitled "An ordinance authorizing the issuance of \$25,000 of the bonds of the city of Medford," approved March 22, 1911, is hereby amended by striking out the last clause of said section reading "both principal and interest to be payable at the office of the treasurer of the city of Medford in said city," and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "Both principal and interest to be payable at the Fort Dearborn National Bank in the city of Chicago, Illinois."

As there is urgent need for improvements to be made in the water main and sewer systems and in the fire department of the city of Medford, and it is made under said bonds are issued, an emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the mayor.
