the improvement of streets and laying of sewers in incorporated cities, and for the payment of the cost of such improvements and laying of sewers by installments, as set forth in the ordinance of the State of Oregon, entitled "An act to improve the streets and laying of sewers by installments," approved February 23rd, 1901, and is an obligation of the City of Medford, aforesaid, and is not to be deemed or taken to be a part of any contract to be entered into by law, or by the incorporation of said city, and it is further certified that all the requirements of law have been fully complied with by the proper officers of said city, and that the total amount of this issue does not exceed the limit prescribed by said Act.

This bond is redeemable at the office of said treasurer at the option of the City of Medford upon the payment of the face value thereof, with accrued interest to the date of payment at any time during the period of six months from the date hereof, as provided in said Act.

For the fulfillment of the conditions of this obligation the faith and credit of the City of Medford are hereby pledged.

ORDINANCE NO. 661.

An ordinance providing for the execution of a contract with the Jacobsen-Bade company, an Oregon corporation, for the furnishing and backfilling trenches, and furnishing and laying pipe and placing hydrants and other equipment in the construction of water works in the City of Medford, particularly enumerated in said ordinance, and providing the terms of said contract:

Section 1. That the proposition of the Jacobsen-Bade company, an Oregon corporation, for furnishing and backfilling trenches, and furnishing and laying pipe and placing hydrants and other equipment in the construction of water works in the City of Medford, and to be performed by and between the City of Medford, Oregon, and the Clark and Henery Construction Company, a California corporation, hereinbefore called the contractor, of the first part, and the City of Medford, Oregon, of the second part, hereinbefore called the city.

Witnesseth, for and in consideration of the covenants hereinafter set forth the contractor hereby undertakes and covenants for the payment of all materials and labor and to do all the work of excavating and backfilling ditches, hauling and laying pipe and placing hydrants and valves above and below ground and elbows on the following streets and avenues in the City of Medford, Oregon:

1. Plum street, 4 inches..... 2.10
2. South Holly street, 6 inches..... 2.70
3. South Central Avenue, 6 inches..... 1.43
4. South Franklin Avenue, 6 inches..... 1.43

Said contractor shall furnish all hydrants and gate valves, and all crosses, tees and elbows at the points indicated on the plans and specifications for the work and materials at the office of the city recorder, which plans and specifications have been adopted by the city recorder of said city, and the paving shall be laid either with a four inch asphaltic concrete base and a one and one-half inch asphaltic wearing surface, or a three inch asphaltic concrete base and a one inch asphaltic wearing surface, as the said city shall elect. The said forms of said pavement on each of any of the above mentioned streets, and to make election at any time before the contractor is ready to start work on a particular street.

Said pavement shall be laid and work done in accordance with the specifications, therefore, hereinbefore submitted by and between the Jacobsen-Bade company, an Oregon corporation, hereinbefore named as the contractor, and the City of Medford, a municipal corporation, hereinbefore named as the city.

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
