They were in nowise pacified when they learned that they would be required to pay a certificate fee of \$1 and an irrigation fee of \$2.50 for the first 16 acres watered, with a graduated fee per acre for every acre

> Time and again Superintendent James T. Chinnock, for water division No. 1, explained that the purpose of the registration was to make the rights secure rather than to raise any rights secure rather than to raise any question as to their validity, and that the coming adjudication will result in a permanent apportionment of the water which will eliminate the water 2 hog and prevent encroachment by reason of later locations. When the pioneers heard this explanation, they 0 were pleased at the wisdom of the 2 state in making them secure in their rights, thereby insuring them against possible litigation with conflicting claimants.

Upwards of 75 registrations were taken here, representing water rights on Sams creek, Sardine creek, Galls ereek, Wards ereek, Birdseye, ereek, Foots creek, Evans creek, Kane creek and Rogne river.

The oldest right registered was one owned by J. W. Hayes, which was secured from the government by Jacob Gall, on the creek named after him, in 1856.
