There will be 200 rear seats which may be reserved free, these for use of those who do not feel that they can pay anything to attend the entertainments.

The first entertainment will be given by Edmund Vance Cook, the famous Ohio poet and humorist at the Medford Natatorium next Monday night, October 23.
