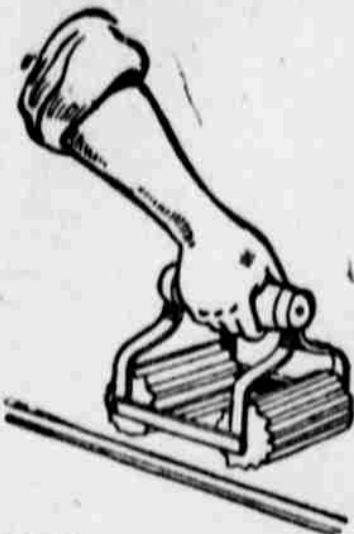


HINTS FOR THE BUSY HOUSEWIFE
