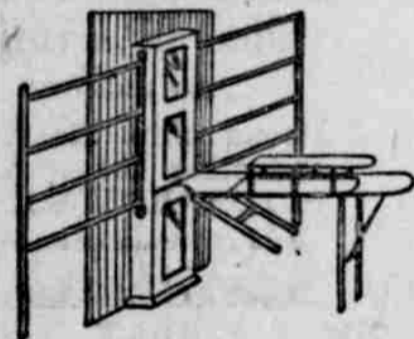

HINTS FOR THE BUSY HOUSEWIFE

Ironing Cabinet That Folds Into Small Space.



The Iowa man who designed the ironing cabinet herewith shown arranged an ordinary ironing board with a sieve ironing board within it and two racks on which to hang the clothing and then so contrived that the whole affair could be folded up.

To Hull Corn With Ashes. Take one pint of good, clean wood ashes, put them in a cheesecloth bag and put in an iron or granite kettle that holds six or eight quarts of water.
