TO GIVE COURSE IN PEAR GROWING

Twenty Exercises at Oregon Agricultural College Short Course Will Be Devoted to the Pear Alone-Leetures and Field Practice Arranged

OREGON AGRICULTURAL COL-LEGE, CORVALLIS, Ore., Nov. 1 .-A special course in pear growing is to be given at the Oregon Agriculturnl college this winter as a part of the short course. At least twenty excreises will be devoted to the pear nione, including lectures, laboratory work and field practice.

"We will treat first of the general status of the pear industry in the United States at the present time," and Prof. C. t. Lewis, head of the division of horticulture, in discussing short course plans, today, "I have had a heavy correspondence working up the material concernius the different varieties preferred by Individual markets, both in America and abroad.

"We will study, of course, the choice of location for pear orchards, including the sell, elevation and exposure, with hints on the planting of the orchard. Drainage and irrigation will be discussed, as will also the use of cover crops, methods of pruning, thinning, harvesting and packing the crop.


