

HIGHEST PRICE PAID FOR PRUNES

Cash Value of Shipment Made by
J. W. Lozier Is \$9000—150 Tons
of This Fruit Is Shipped Out of
Valley.

J. W. Lozier, who has been buying prunes in the valley has already shipped 150 tons of this fruit. The price paid ranges from 6 1/4 to 8 1/2 cents per pound, which is the highest price ever paid for prunes in the valley. The cash value of this shipment amounts to \$9000.

CONTESTING RIGHT OF LINDSAY TO LAND

A contest is being held today in United States Commissioner Canon's court wherein the government is contesting the right of William Lindsay to acquire title to land in section 14, township 38 south of range 3 east. Final proof was made on this land, which was Mr. Lindsay's homestead, four years ago, and before patent issued for the land a protest was filed by the government forest service, alleging a non-compliance of the homestead laws in the matter of residence.

Several witnesses are giving testimony both for the government and the contestee and the entire day will be required to close up the case.

\$4500 IS PAID FOR 75 ACRES LAND

Chas. Hanson and Arthur Toulville have purchased 75 acres of land from C. A. Pruitt. The land is situated just half a mile south of the Butte creek bridge, near Eagle Point, and the price paid was \$4500.
