

## LOW RATE FOR TRIP SOUTH

Los Angeles Excursion Will Leave Medford This Year on December 27—Tickets Will Be Good for Ninety Days.

In an interview into yesterday afternoon with John M. Scott, general passenger agent of the Southern Pacific company, Mr. Scott was asked if he would again grant Medford a n excursion rate to Los Angeles. Mr. Scott replied that he had given the matter consideration since taking charge of the passenger traffic of the Southern Pacific and would authorize the local agent, Mr. Rosenbaum, to go ahead and arrange for the excursion, further stating the date would be December 27 and instead of a 30-day limit the tickets would be limited to 90 days, with stopover privileges in either direction. Good equipment will be furnished and everything possible done to make the excursion as successful as those of previous years.

Mr. Scott stated the Los Angeles excursion from here last January greatly exceeded in numbers the expectation of all the railroad officials, 102 people taking advantage of the low rate—a remarkable showing for Medford.

## PRESIDENT PLANS GREAT LOVE FEAST

WASHINGTON, D. C., Nov., 23.—President Taft will be host to all members of the republican national committee at a dinner in the White House December 1, for which invitations are out today. The dinner is regarded as the active commencement of the real work of the president's campaign for re-election in 1912, and is considered as a love feast for the purpose of solidifying the party.

The dinner is expected to draw a sharp line between the insurgents and the standpat factions of the republican party. Fifty will be present, including all the national committeemen and the officers of the national committee, as well as several of the cabinet members.
