

The work of laying the first course of erushed rock on the Central Point boulevard by Twohy Bros. is progressing rapidly, but it will be several weeks yet before the road is fit to travel. At present it is very rough and it will remain so until the top course of fine rock is laid.

The contractors plan to get the ernshed rock laid first for the entire distance for then, despite the rain, the top course of rock can be hauled onto the road and graded. This method of constructing the road is making it very rought and unfit for travel.


