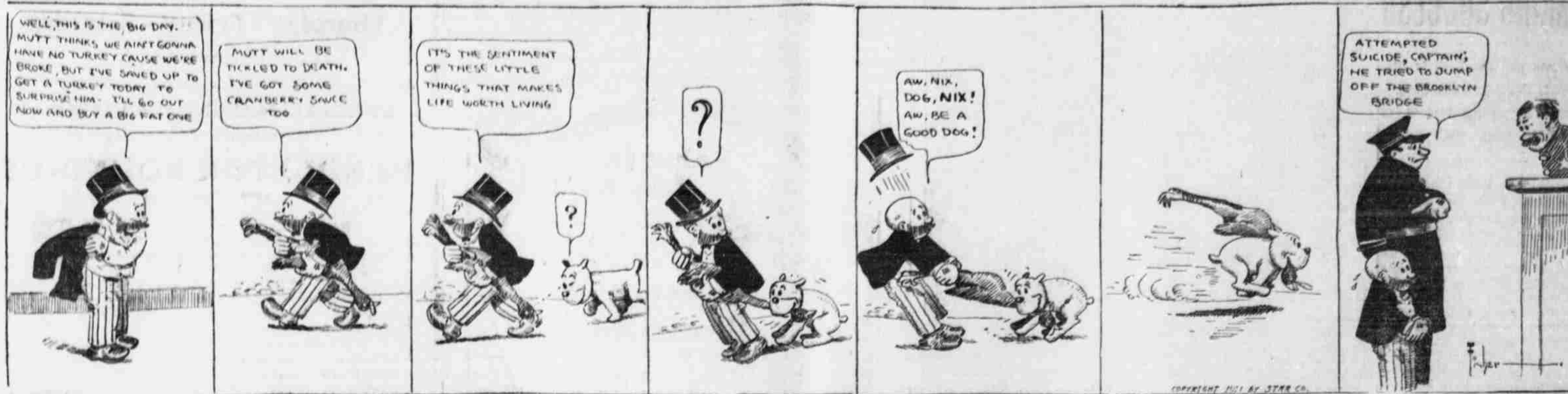

HARRIMAN SYSTEM TO BUILD NEW LINE

OSE, Idaho, Dec. 7.—Railroad men today declare that the Harriman system will proceed immediately with the construction of the Oregon and Eastern railroad from Vale into the interior of the south central Oregon via Burns, thence to the Pacific slope. The Utah Construction company, which handles all the system's big intermountain contracts has just placed a big rush order for \$11,000 worth of food to be distributed along the right of way, and grading crews are already working in Malheur Canyon. The proposed line would tap a rich agricultural and stock country.
