

**WOMAN, 71, ROUTS ROBBERS WITH CLUB**

SAN FRANCISCO, Cal., Dec. 15.—Swinging an ancient war Indian club Mrs. M. Holder, 71 years old, knocked two highwaymen out at her home here at an early hour yesterday and then ran to the police station and prepared to give herself up for murder. But one of the thugs had recovered, doused the other with water and assisted him away before the officers arrived.

The men entered her house. One told her to get her money and the other went to the yard in the rear to watch. Instead of money she returned with the concealed club, swung it on the first crook's head, ran into the yard, knocked the second to the ground and continued on to the street, on the fastest mile ever recorded for aged sprinters, to the nearest police station.
