VIENNA, Dec. 19.—Serious illness of Emperor Franz Josef today is reviving fears that the end of the aged "Unele of Europe" is near, and that a period of unrest and, possibly, of war in the Balkans will follow.

The emperor had a bad night. He is subject to violent coughing spells and these, at his advanced age, are believed to be dangerous. Should his heart weaken, the end may come at any time.

Unofficially it is stated that the emperor is suffering from a severe cold and eatarrh, but there is little doubt that the greatest apprehension is felt in court circles.
