## CITY NOTICES.

### ORDINANCE NO. 637.

An ordinance declaring the assessment on the proposed water main for the laying of a 4-inch water main on East Ninth street from Portland avenue west to city limits, and directing the recorder to enter the statement thereof in the city records.

The City of Medford does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Whereas, the city council did heretofore by resolution declare its intention at to lay a 4-inch water main on East Ninth street from Portland avenue west to city limits, and to assess the cost thereof on the property situated on said portion of said street in proportion to the frontage of said property, and fix a time and place for hearing protests against the laying of said water main on account of damage to the same, and the assessment of the cost thereof an aforesaid.

And whereas, said resolution was duly published and posted as required in section 115 of the charter of said city.

And whereas, a meeting of the council was held at the time and place fixed by said resolution for the purpose of causing the same to be heard, but no protests were at said time, or at any other time, made to or received by the council as to the laying of said water main on the property situated on said portion of said street, and said council having considered the matter and desiring that said water main was and is of much benefit to said city and all property to be assessed therefor would be benefited thereby to the extent of the probable amount of the respective assessments to be levied against said property, did order and command as follows:

And whereas, the cost of said water main has been and hereby is determined to be the sum of \$32,14.

Now therefore, be it hereby further determined that the proportionate share of the cost of laying said water main of each parcel of property fronting on said street shall be assessed on the amount opposite the description of each parcel of land below, and that each piece or parcel of land, having the full extent to the amount set opposite the description of the same, and that the respective amounts represent the proportional benefits of said water main to said real estate of land, also the proportional frontage thereof on said street, the council does hereby declare each of the parcels of property described above, but not less than the amount set opposite such description for the cost of laying said water main. The name and address of the owner or record title of each such lot or parcel.
