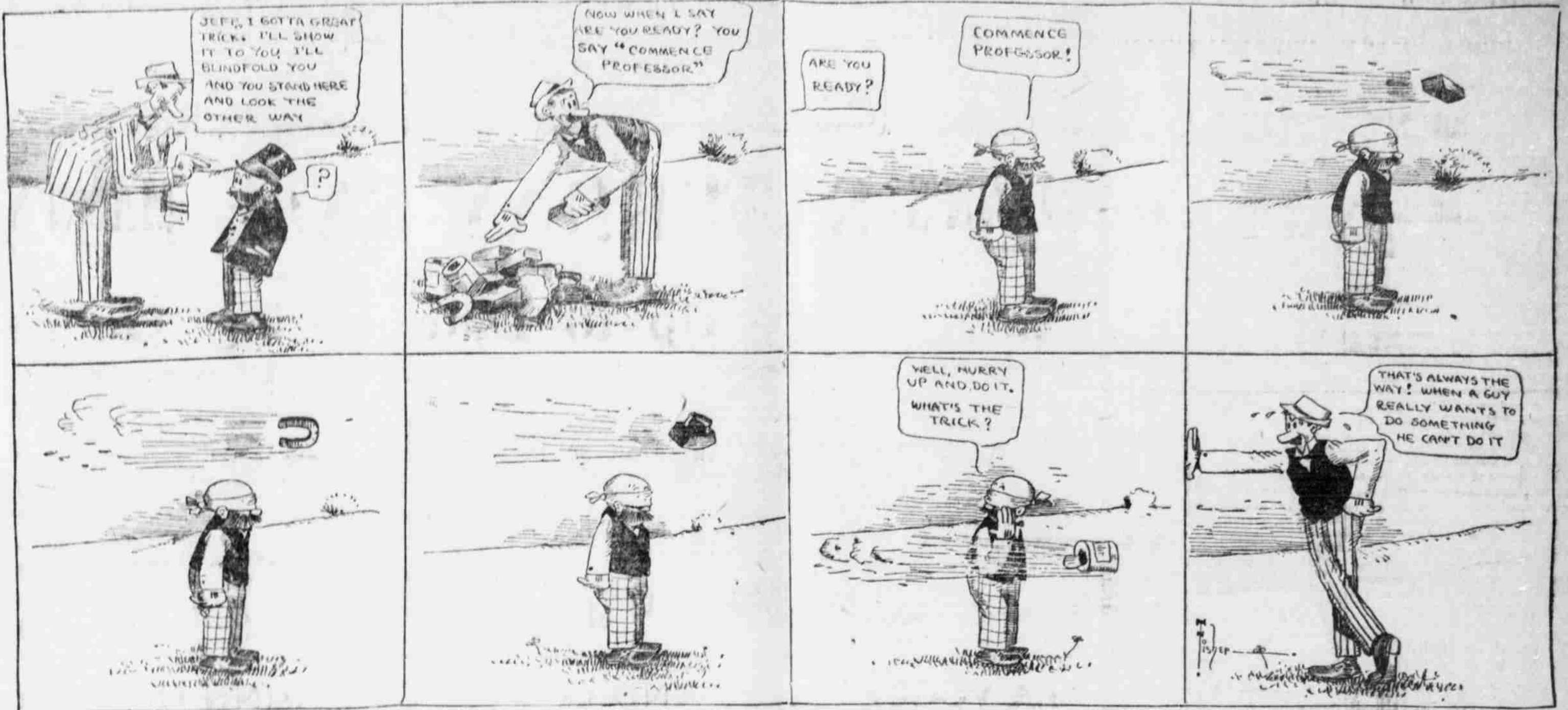


Mutt's Aim Wasn't as Good as His Intentions
