### MEDFORD LEADS THE STATE.

Statistics furnished by Secretary of State Oicott show that there were 6417 licenses for automobiles issued during 1911 in Oregon. Of these half were issued for Portland alone, the number of licenses for the metropolis totalling 3208.

Medford, with 243, ranks third in the list of cities, Salem with 277 exceeding her. Eugene with 150 is fourth and Hood River fifth with 117. Some Medford owners have evidently not complied with law, for there are more than 243 cars in the city.

However, taking the secretary's figures in the number of automobiles compared to population, Medford leads the state, having one automobile to every 36 inhabitants, as against one to every 64 in Portland, one to every 50 in Salem and one to every 60 in


