LEGAL NOTICES

ORDINANCE NO. 659.
An ordinance establishing paid fire department in the City of Medford, Oregon.

The City of Medford does ordain as follows:

Section 1. There shall be established in the City of Medford a paid fire department consisting of a chief, assistant chief and such number of firemen as may from time to time deem necessary. Until otherwise ordered by the council there shall be four firemen in addition to the chief and assistant chief.

Section 2. The salary of the chief of the fire department shall be \$50 per month, that of the assistant chief \$45 per month, and that of each of the firemen shall be \$5 per month.

Section 3. The council shall from time to time make such regulations and rules as it deems fit for the operation of the department as it shall see fit.

Section 4. The mayor of the City of Medford shall appoint from time to time an auditor to receive all bills presented to the department subject to the confirmation of the council.

Section 5. Every person employed on the paid fire department shall hold his position at the pleasure of the mayor and council. The mayor may suspend any employee of the department at any time and for any reason during the term of his office, and the council when said matter shall come before the council for its action and such suspension shall become permanent unless disapproved by a majority of all the members.

The foregoing ordinance was passed by the City Council of the City of Medford, Oregon, on the 1st day of March, 1912, following date: Watt, aye; Mitchell, aye; Emeric, absent; Ireland, aye; Miller, no; and Summerville, aye. Approved March 6th, 1912.
