

MILL TO WORK ORES PLANNED

The recent incorporation, at Portland, of a company to construct and operate a custom mill to work the gold ores of this section marks another important step in the line of progress of this naturally gifted area tributary to the Rogue river. Realizing the importance of having such a plant in this neighborhood the citizens of the little city of Gold Hill have offered the milling company a tract of land embracing two acres, which is advantageously situated between the tracks of the Southern Pacific railroad company and the Rogue river.

With such a plant in operation the prospectors and small miners will have means at hand whereby they will be able to convert their rock into gold ore thus enabling them to more thoroughly prospect and develop their properties.

It is a well known fact that there are thousands of tons of ore scattered on the innumerable mine dumps throughout this section which owing to the distance to the necessary reduction works have never been moved. In the early history of mining in the Rogue river country none but the very highest grade of rock was shipped, the ores of lesser values were simply left on the dumps awaiting a more favorable time. That time is now here and the heretofore discouraged prospectors and miners will soon be hauling this ore—which nearly all carries good milling values—to the mill and get the money for it.

There are many ore dumps within easy reach of the railroad on which there are from five to fifty or sixty tons of gold ores which will be hauled to the mill and the values extracted. In fact a custom mill will be a bank to the prospector and miner. Instead of bemoaning hard times and waiting for someone to come along and buy the property they will go to work and in a very short while many of them will be on Easy Street.

ORDINANCE NO. 663.

An ordinance assessing the property adjacent to and benefited by the six acre avenue from Main street to point 175 feet south of Scott street, for the cost of constructing the same and providing the manner of carrying said assessment into full effect.

The City of Medford doth ordain as follows:

Section 1. Whereas, the City Council doth heretofore provide by ordinance for the serving of the owners of property adjacent to and benefited by the construction of the last named improvement described to appear before said Council and show cause, if any, why said property would not be assessed for the construction of the same, and fix a sum for hearing, protests and to whom the same is due, and that when notice was given in accordance with the provisions of said ordinance, the same was not paid, then to assess the cost of construction of the same to the owner of record, and to collect the same in the manner provided by the charter of said city for the collection of assessments for the improvements of streets therin.

Section 2. It is further ordered that the notice above provided for be published three times in the Daily Mail Tribune, a newspaper published and of general circulation in said city, in the manner provided by ordinance No. 259 of said city.
