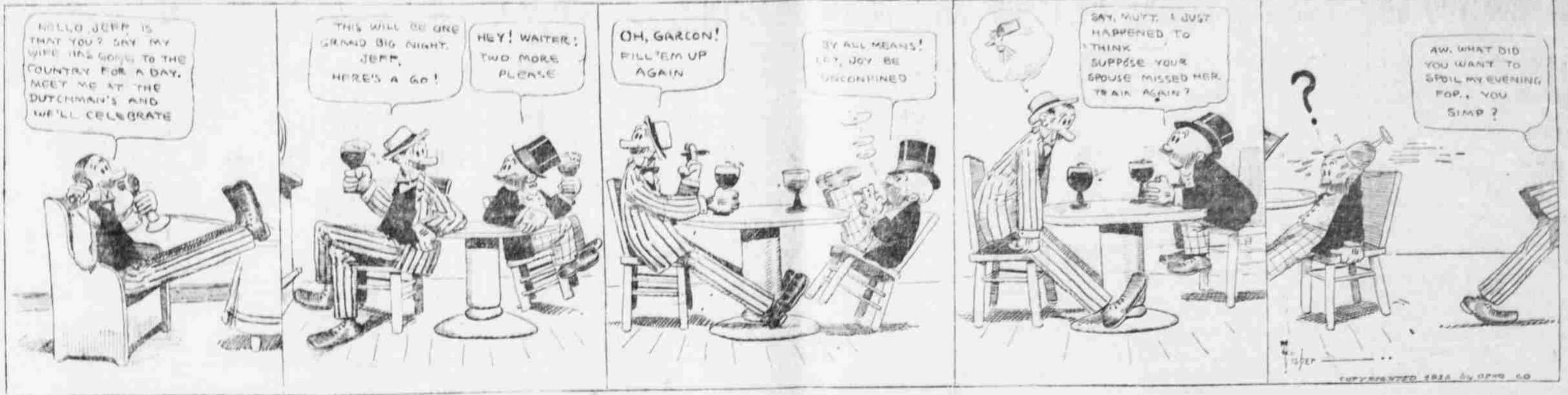


Laying All Jokes Aside, Jeff Is a Bit Too Pessimistic
