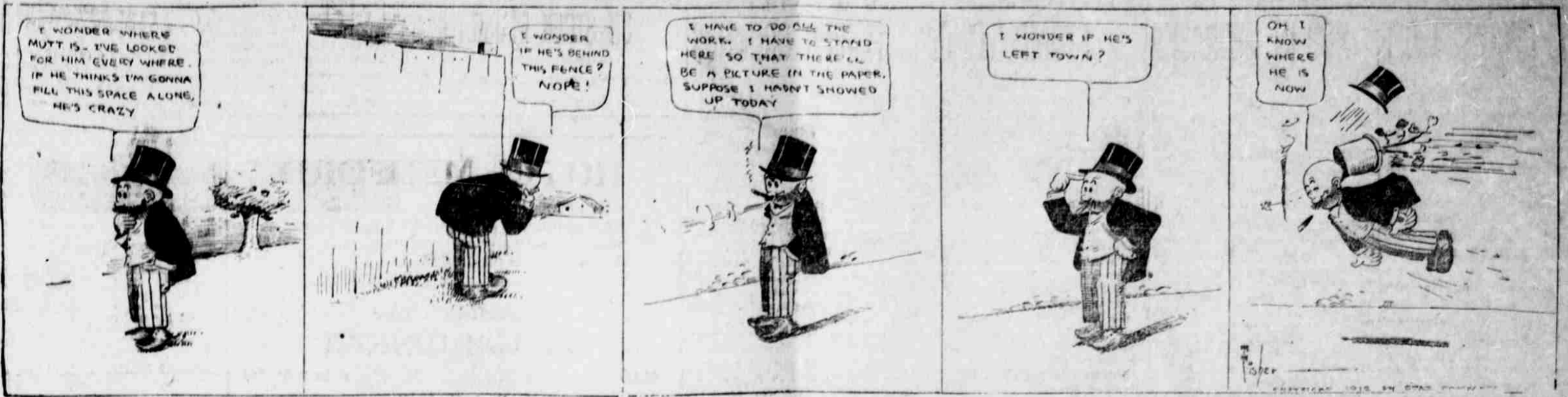


Mutt and Jeff Finally Get Across the Mississippi River Flood
