REGISTRATION 5288 PRIMARY ELECTION

Of a total registration of 5288 for the primary election, Medford with 1843 has more than a third of the entire voting strength of the county.

The republican strength is more than all other parties combined by 1462 votes, having a voting strength of 3375. Democrats have 1325, socialists 281, independents 231, prohibitionists 64 and populists 2. Of the republican and democrat parties, Medford in the grand total has more than a third of the entire count. In the socialists, prohibitionists and independents Medford has less than a fourth, and the two "pops" are from some other city than Medford.

This city with six precincts gives the republicans 1228, democrats 467, socialists 82, prohibitionists 14 and independents 51.

The registration is by far the largest primary registration ever held, and in number of votes is more than was polled at the bond election.
