TWO YEARS PEACE IN COAL FIELDS

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind., April: 16 .-Provision for two years' peace in the bituminous coal fields is made today in the approval, by a referendum vote of the miners, of the bituminous wage scale compromise.

The agreement thus reached by miners and mine owners provides for an increase in wages of 5 cents per ton for mining screened coal and 3 cents a ton for unscreened coal. All helpers, drivers and other men employed in the mines are to receive an increase of 5 % per cent in wages.
