

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RESOLUTION AND CHARTER AMENDMENTS.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Medford:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is submitted to the legal voters of the City of Medford for their adoption or rejection at a special election appointed at the third Monday within the month of May, 1912, the following proposed acts of municipal legislation:

1. An act to amend section 84 and section 116 of the charter of the City of Medford do as follows:

Sec. 1. That sections 84 of the charter of the City of Medford be and the same hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 84. A sum of money assessed for the improvement of a street shall be collected in the following manner: Notice shall be given to the owner or reputed owner of the property assessed as named in the bill recorded in the office of city treasurer that said assessment has been made and that therefor entered of record in the city docket, and that the same is due, and requiring the same to be paid to the City Recorder, within ten days from the service of said notice, and that it shall be served by the City Recorder by publication in some newspaper, by order of the City Recorder, in one publication thereof, in such manner as the council shall by ordinance prescribe.

Sec. 2. That section 116 of the charter of the City of Medford be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 84. A sum of money assessed for the improvement of a street shall be collected in the following manner: Notice shall be given to the owner or reputed owner of the property assessed as named in the bill recorded in the office of city treasurer that said assessment has been made and that therefor entered of record in the city docket, and that the same is due, and requiring the same to be paid to the City Recorder, within ten days from the service of said notice, and that it shall be served by the City Recorder by publication in some newspaper, by order of the City Recorder, in one publication thereof, in such manner as the council shall by ordinance prescribe.

Sec. 3. An act to amend the charter of the City of Medford giving the City Council of said city power and authority to prohibit and prevent sparring matches, glove contests and prizefights in said city.

The powers of the City of Medford do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That the charter of the City of Medford be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto the following:

Sec. 129. The City Council of said city in addition to all of the powers hereinabove given to said council shall have power and authority to prohibit and prevent sparring matches, glove contests and prizefights within the limits of said city.

Sec. 130. An act to amend the charter of the City of Medford establishing a municipal court in and for said city and amending sections 131, 132, 133, 134 and 135 of the charter.

The people of the City of Medford do ordain as follows:

Sec. 131. There is hereby created in the City of Medford a court to be known as the municipal court. It shall have full and exclusive jurisdiction of all violations of city ordinances with full power to enforce and judgments it may render in the same manner as judgments of justice courts of this state are, or may from time to time be enacted, under the laws of this state.

Transcripts of such judgments may be filed in the office of the County Clerk with like effect in like manner as transcripts by law in the case of judgments of such justice courts, and appeals from such judgments may be taken into circuit courts of said state for decision, and in the same manner under the same circumstances as in the case of judgments of such justice courts.

Sec. 141. All proceedings in said court shall be governed and regulated by the laws of the State of Oregon in relation to justice courts, including taxation of costs and disbursements, except that there shall be no trial by jury in said court.

Sec. 142. All fines and costs collected in said court shall be turned over to the City Treasurer by the judge of said court, and said judge shall make a monthly report in writing thereof to the City Council.
