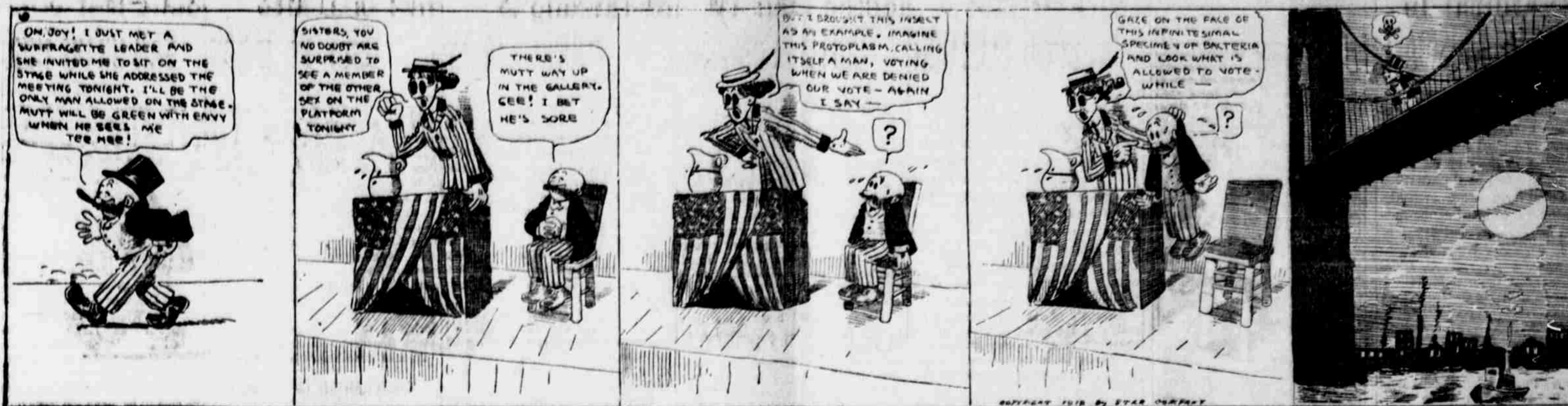

LONDON, May 28.—An attempt to break the strike of 100,000 store-dores and lightermen, which has badly crippled British shipping, was started today at the Victoria and Albert docks here. Police guarded the strikebreakers, who began unloading tons of perishable freight which had been accumulating for several days. The strikers, however, did not interfere and there was no disorder.
