CHICAGO, June 8.—Colonel W. P. Stone, sergeant at arms of the Republican national committee has appealed to Mayor Harrison for police protection at today's session of the committee.

HEAVY BUSINESS PUBLIC MARKET

Saturday saw the greatest day's business yet experienced at the public market. The large building was jammed during the morning hours with an eager throng of buyers while each and every stall at the market was occupied.

Meats were on sale this morning and a line of women extending through the building testified to its attractiveness as a drawing card. A large business was done at the meat stall while across the aisle a farmer offered a large number of country hams, bacon and lard and did a splendid business.

Before 8:30 a. m. over 200 chickens had been disposed of at the market. R. P. Little brought over a load of poultry and was not permitted to reach a stall the women buying all he had to offer before he could get inside of the building.

The offerings of vegetables were very large and covered a wide range. New potatoes were a feature and were eagerly seized upon. Fully 600 buyers patronized the market before noon today. At 9 o'clock this morning a count showed 180 in the market at one time.

WARN BUYERS OF RAILROAD LAND

Applications for the purchase of lands granted by congress to the Oregon and California railroad company are being offered for sale in Medford and surrounding towns under the representation that the pending suit will be decided adversely to the railroad and the lands opened for settlement.
