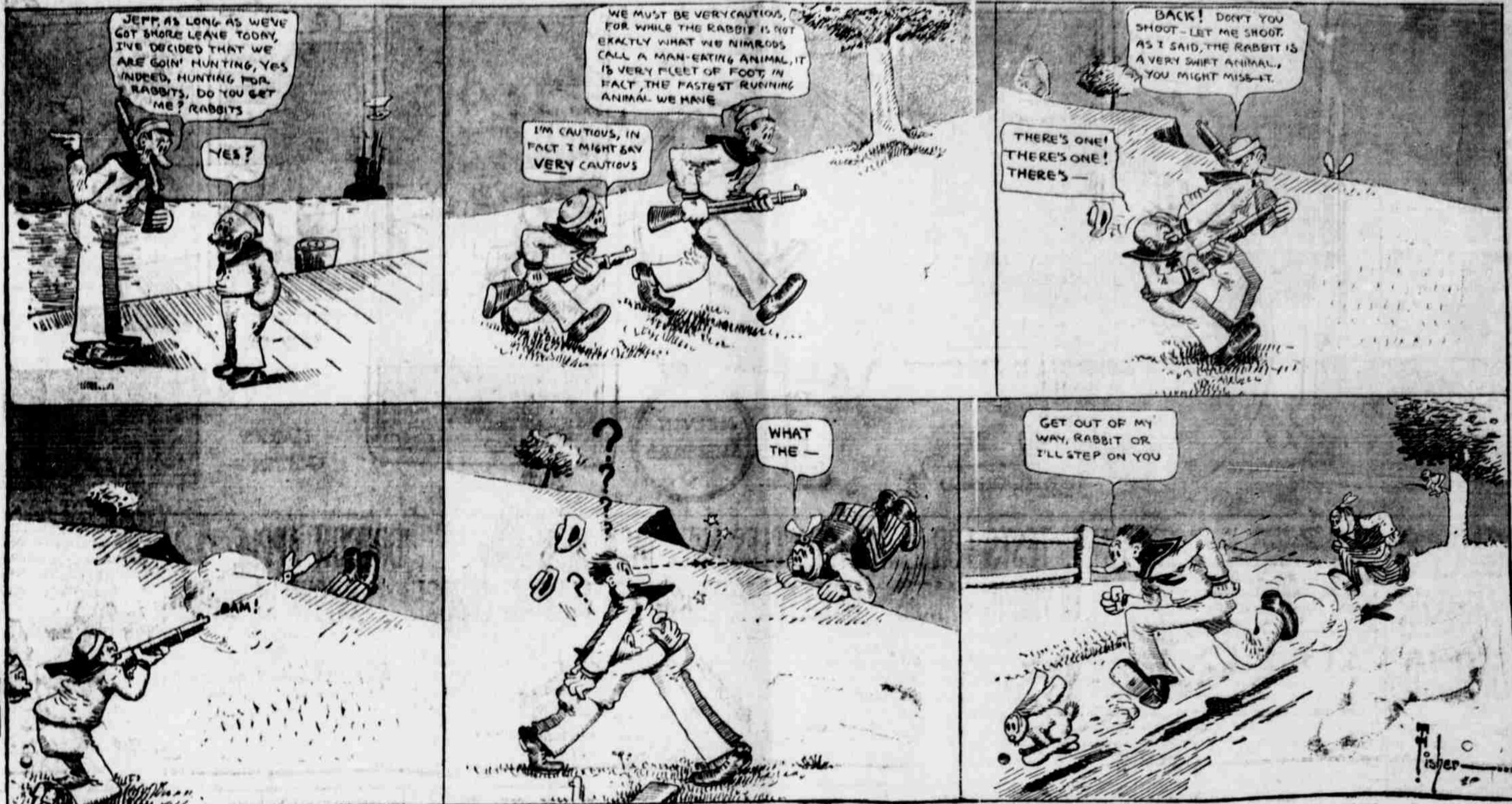

START TO BUST ALUMINUM TRUST

PITTSBURG, Pa., June 8.—Proceedings for the dissolution of the "aluminum trust" were begun today when a motion for a decree restraining the trust from continuing its alleged violations of the Sherman anti-trust law was entered in the United States circuit court here by attorneys for the government, which controls 90 per cent of the aluminum output through a system of restrictive contracts, has agreed to nullify these contracts.

PEKIN, June 8.—Hardly a day passes without the discovery of some plot to assassinate President Yuan Shi Kai, who is equally hated by the supporters of the fallen Manchus and by the republicans, whom believe he is contemplating establishing a monarchy or dictatorship of his own. The most formidable individual recently chosen to remove the Chinese executive was Tseng Kwang, head of the republican "iron and blood" corps at Tien Tsin, who received as the government rather indefinitely expresses it, a bribe of "several tens of thousands of dollars," from Leh Liang, a
