DARROW TRIAL MAY HALT AS RESULT OF SPLIT

LOS ANGELES, June 15.—Participation of Attorney Rogers in the McNamara prosecution confronted him today in the Darrow trial. It not only threatened to cause Rogers' withdrawal as chief counsel for Darrow, but may stop the present trial. This was the construction placed upon it by District Attorney Fredericks by the declaration that the prosecution would not proceed if Rogers won his request to have Olaf A. Tveitmo and Anton Johannsen placed on the stand tomorrow to clear up a point of divergence between Rogers and Darrow arising out of the Caplan letter which came into the evidence yesterday and which, according to Rogers, involved the preservation of Darrow's rights. Rogers argued his position was intolerable and unless evidence at once was submitted showing his part in the Caplan matter while engaged in clearing up the Times explosion conspiracy, it would be impossible for him to proceed in the Darrow trial and jeopardize his client's interests.
