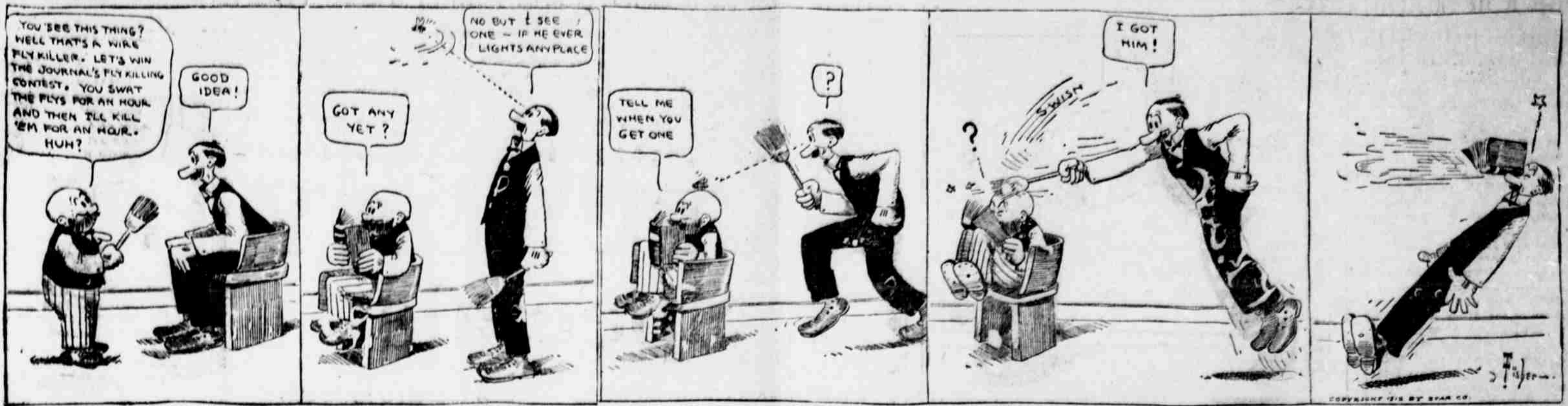


Mutt and Jeff Swat the Fly, or, Rather, Mutt Does

MURDERER SHOT FROM AMBUSH

REDDING, Cal., July 19.—Shot from ambush, William C. Landis, of Buckeye, who killed Mrs. W. C. Bradford there two months ago in a neighborhood row, is dead today. It is believed he was killed for revenge, and William and John Clement, sons of Mrs. Bradford, and Dan Thompson, their friend, have been arrested.

Landis who was postmaster at Buckeye, a camp near here, shot Mrs. Bradford on May 31, following a quarrel. He claimed self defense, and his friends never doubted that he would be acquitted. He gave himself up after the shooting and had been in jail until yesterday, when he was released on \$15,000 bail. The merchant was warned away from Buckeye, but declared he was prepared and would take his chances. Landis' team was seen driving along a lonely road by neighbors, with Landis flying bullets in the seat. Examination showed that he had been shot from in front, the bullet penetrating his breast. His revolver, fully loaded, lay near. Evidently he had seen and recognized his assailant but had not been quick enough for him.
