DANVILLE, Ill., Nov. 7.—Democratic leaders here today estimated that O'Hair, democrat defeated former Speaker Joseph G. Cannon, for congress by 1,500. The republicans will not concede that Cannon is beaten, declaring that missing precincts are strongly for "Uncle Joe."

IOWA FOR WILSON BY 15,000 PLURALITY

DES MOINES, Iowa, Nov. 7.—With returns missing from only one county President-Elect Wilson's plurality over Colonel Roosevelt in Iowa today stands at 15,000. The republican state ticket is elected by pluralities ranging from 4,000 to 6,000.

NEEDHAM DEFEATED IN FRESNO DISTRICT

FRESNO, Cal., Nov. 7.—James Needham has been defeated for reelection to congress in the Seventh district by Denver S. Church, democrat, by 500 or 600 votes, according to the latest returns. Wilson carried Fresno county over Roosevelt by about 100 votes.

WILSON'S BIG LEAD IN TAFT'S OWN STATE

COLUMBUS, Ohio, Nov. 7.—Complete returns today from 70 of the 80 counties in Ohio, President Taft's native state, give Wilson 345,100; Taft, 229,680; Roosevelt 18,020.
