The new hill had a checkered career in the house. Its purpose was to amend a section of the code giving road districts the power to levy special taxes for the building of roads, and which had been declared unconstitutional for a number of reasons among others, that it did not definitely outline the procedure to be followed in posting the election notices Members of the house opposed it on the ground that it would be unconstutional in that it sought to validate assessments made under the section of the code which the su preme court had held to be unconstational. The attorney general takes a contrary view, and says:

Section 3 is an emergency clause putting the act into immediate force and effect. Therefore, the act is in effect at the present time, and the effect to the curative part of the act is to validate all road faxes now levied and collectible-providing the net itself is constitutional The rule in such cases is that the legislature has the power to validate any and it deemed it wise so to do; in other words, the legislature could levy special road taxes up to a certain amount without notice. Therefore, I am of the opinion that the curative net is constutional, and that all road taxes are collectible."


