The first fair on the Southern Oregon circuit will be held at Medford on September 10, 11, 12 and 13. followed by Roseburg's fair on September 17, 18, 19 and 20. Lane county's fair will be held at Eugene September 24, 25, 26 and 27. From Eugene most of the stock and exhibits will be shipped to Salem for the State fair, which will be held the following week.

The racing programs for the three Southern Oregon fairs are as near uniform as it was possible to make them. They include the usual trotting, pacing and running events. The purses for each of the three fairs aggregate \$3775. As far as financing their respective fairs, the three counties included in the organization will be distinct, their affiliation being chiefly for the purpose of arranging race cards and dates which will not conflict.
