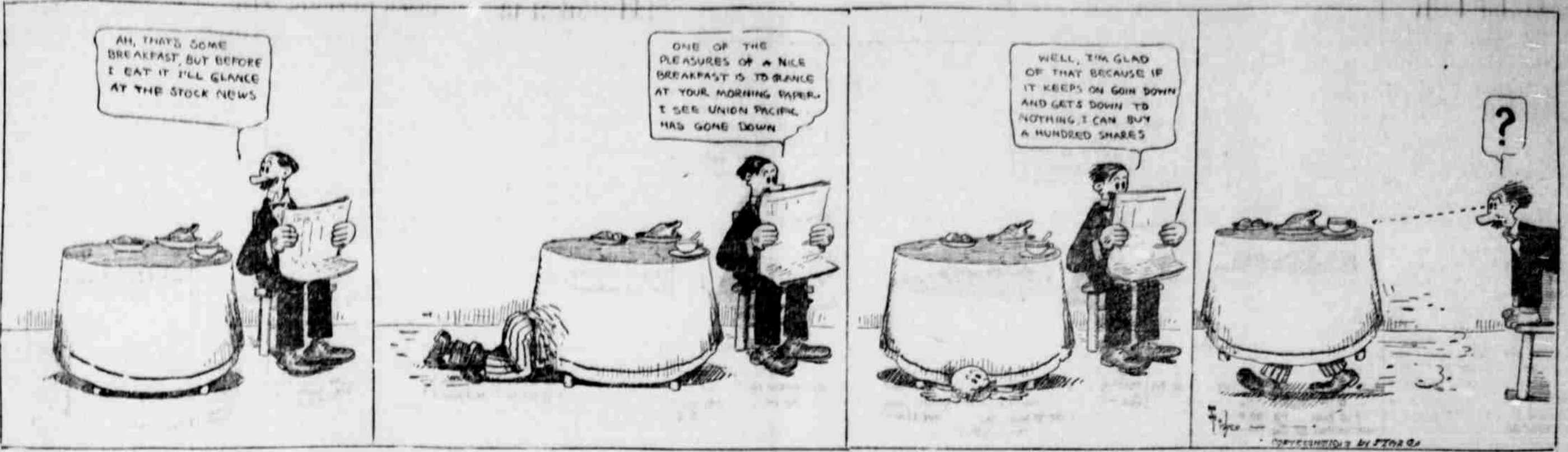


Mutt Didn't Believe in Spiritualism, but He Does Now
