**ASHLAND TO HAVE A  
REAL LIVE NEWSPAPER**

With its issue of last week the  
Ashland Record completed twenty-  
five years of its existence and with  
this issue starts on its twenty-sixth  
year. During the coming year the  
editor will put in four new linotypes  
costing \$16,000 and a \$20,000 press  
that will print and fold forty thou-  
sand papers an hour. He will also  
build a ten-story building and issue  
a daily of thirty-two pages. It will  
be delivered free to everybody within  
one hundred miles of Ashland. Pre-  
liminary surveys have already been  
made. Blue prints are now on file.  
Active operations will be begun as  
soon as somebody dies and leaves the  
editor a million dollars.

CLEMENT—At Millville, Shasta

## VOTERS USE NEW WEAPONS.

A MUNICIPAL election held Tuesday in San Francisco is interesting in that the people were called upon to use the three new weapons that populist politics have given them, the referendum, the initiative and the recall. Over 60,000 citizens were interested sufficiently to vote. People were asked to approve or reject an act of the administration, adopt or reject an ordinance cutting the rates of a public service corporation, and virtually try a judge for his judicial acts.

By a vote of two to one the street railroad agreement submitted to the people by the supervisors was ratified. It extends the municipally owned Geary street railway to the ferries and does away with the ancient horse car, and makes other changes.

The ordinance initiated by the Telephone Users' association, was adopted by three thousand majority. It cuts the rates charged by the telephone companies and marks the entrance of the grafter into the initiative legislative business. The association is fathered by a politician who formerly fattened off legislatures or corporations affected by pending legislation, and who has discovered in the new regime opportunity to wax fat at public expense. This "association" hired agents and obtained contracts with thousands of business men to the effect that if rates were reduced through the effort of the association, it should receive a certain percentage of the reduction. The people voted the reduction, therefore the enterprising grafter gets the people to pay him for what they have made possible by their own votes.

The recall movement was also successful. Judge Charles Weller being recalled and Wiley Crist, candidate of the Woman's Recall League being elected by 877 majority. It is a triumph of women in politics and disproves the oft repeated story that the fair sex are not interested enough in public questions to vote. The recall grew out of Judge Weller's action in reducing the bail of a man who criminally assaulted a girl, thus allowing the assailant to escape. The bail had been set at \$3000 by one judge and Judge Weller reduced it to \$1000, which was furnished, the accused man disappearing and forfeiting the bail. The campaign was waged on moral lines, and as a result, courts will not be so lenient with this class of degenerates.

The initiative, referendum and recall are evidently appreciated by the people of California and have come to stay.

## JOHNSON'S PROTEST.

IT is hard to understand why California's proposed anti-alien law should be considered a matter of such international importance that Secretary of State Bryan must be sent across the continent as special envoy of the president to discuss its terms. But perhaps instead of being offended at the attention attracted, Governor Johnson should be flattered at the consideration shown California. Says the governor:

Much has been said of the dignity of Japan. We would not willingly affront the dignity of Japan, nor offend its pride. But what shall be said of the proposition that a great state, itself an empire of possibilities greater than those of most nations, shall be halted from the mere consideration of a legislative act, admittedly within its jurisdiction, by the protest of a foreign power which has itself enacted even more stringent regulations on the same subject? What of the dignity of California?

The governor points out that California has an unquestioned right to pass an alien land bill; that the United States has determined who are eligible to citizenship and who are not; that the Japanese are among the ineligible races; that the constitution of California since 1879 has declared the "presence of foreigners ineligible to citizenship dangerous to the well-being of the state;" that Washington and Arizona land laws prevent ineligible from owning land in those commonwealths, and that no protest has ever been made except in the case of California, which alone among the states, suffers from the invasion of ineligible races.

California will undoubtedly pass the anti-alien land bill. If the legislature is talked out of it, it will be initiated, and there seems little ground for Japan to protest, when her own laws are similar.

President Wilson at first admitted all these points and refused to interfere. It would be interesting to know what caused the change in policy.

## CUTTING LIVING COST.

IT is estimated by Congressman Underwood that \$300,000,000 and more annually will be sliced off the cost of living by the new tariff, now under consideration. Eventually it will cut off half a billion. Even with this prospect, there is no panic and the familiar and over-worked bogey of hard times does not scare the people. The general sentiment is that if it takes a panic to smash the trusts and reduce the tariff, the quicker it comes, the better.

The deficiency in tariff revenues is expected to be made up by the income tax and the inheritance tax. These two are expected in the future to provide the government's principal source of revenue. Every dollar saved in tariff amounts to five or six dollars in the final retail prices paid by the consumer. This is because the many middle-men who handle an article from the stage of raw material to that of finished product each assesses as profit a certain percentage of the value of the commodity he handles. But in assessing this profit he includes the tariff in the value of the commodity. Thus the people pay not only the tariff but also pay profits on the tariff.

Although no income below \$4000 will be taxed, less than one per cent of the population is affected. This speaks for itself for the concentration of wealth in the hands of a few. Probably the bulk of the income taxation will come from ten per cent of the one per cent taxed.

## Topographic Maps for Public Schools

For teaching the geography of the United States in the public schools and colleges a strong effort is being made by the United States Geological Survey to foster the use of the government topographic maps. These maps contain so many details of local interest, showing even the school houses and farm houses as well as every wagon road, with which of course the school children are familiar, that it is said to be an easy matter for teachers to enlist the interest of the pupils in this new type of school map. From an understanding of the particular maps representing their own localities it is but a succession of short steps to lead the pupils to an appreciation of the different types of country portrayed on maps of other sections of the United States. Most of the standard atlas sheets of the geological survey of recent issue are printed on the scale of one mile to one inch, a scale which shows the physical features of the country in very interesting detail.

With these maps the pupils can determine the altitude of their homes and the steepness of hills and mountains, estimate the grade of wagon roads, work out simple engineering problems such as the drainage of swamps, select dam sites for the construction of reservoirs to supply water to imaginary towns or for irrigation, lay out imaginary trolley or railroad lines or canals along the most feasible routes, establish look-out and signal stations on high points for the control of forest fires, and plan many other similar activities.

The geological survey has published 2200 topographic atlas sheets, covering about 40 per cent of the United States, and on receipt of \$3 from any teacher it will supply 50 different maps selected with special reference to the particular requirements of the class it is proposed to instruct in this new kind of geo-
