

Checking of Campers' Baggage To prevent annoyance and misunderstanding on the part of summer visitors to seaside resorts, we give herewith the rules governing the checking of Campers' Outfits: (a) Campers' Outfit, consisting of tents and tent poles (not exceeding fifteen (15) feet in length, camp stools, folding cots, folding chairs and similar articles, small bundles of bedding (but not bedsteads, box or wire mattresses, bedsprings or cots which do not fold into a compact package not exceeding forty-five (45) inches in any dimension) when securely wrapped and roped or strapped, cooking utensils, when enclosed in proper receptacles, such as boxes with handles, or trunks so that they can be checked and piled same as ordinary baggage, will be checked. On the return journey no boxes or barrels of game will be checked.

(b) Chairs (folding) intended for use at seaside, when they form part of a campers' outfit, when roped and invalid chairs may be checked.
