


Mutt Wasn't as Happy as He Thought He Was

ESTABLISH SCHOOL FOR EXCEPTIONAL CHILD

GREELEY, Colo., July 18.—The establishment in Colorado of a school for the "exceptional child," in which children who because of physical or mental defects are unable to keep pace with normal children in the regular school classes, may have proper educational and medical treatment, was strongly urged today by Professor Grossmann's educational director of the National Educational Association. Professor Grossmann's ideas were set forth in a lecture delivered at the State Teachers' College here. The proposed school, argued Professor Grossmann, would put the nervous or backward child—out of place entirely in the ordinary public school classes—in surroundings which would be most appropriate for its development mentally and physically. The cause of the backwardness would be sought, said Professor Grossmann, and individual "remedies" applied to the children.

DEMOCRATIC AIRS IN DANISH CABINET

COPENHAGEN, July 18.—President Wilson's administration is today being robbed of its claim to being the most democratic cabinet in the world. The new Danish radical ministry has, as a starter, decided that none of its members will hereafter wear uniforms or decorations. They will not even accept the title of "Excellency." Premier Zahle's wife is one of the official stenographers in parliament and she intends keeping the job, though, to avoid any suggestion of graft or avariciousness she will present her saucy, which is \$825 yearly, to the stenographers' fund, while her husband is in office. Mine, Zahle has decided not to go into society at all because of her domestic and office duties and interests. She says she "hasn't the time to attend or give silly parties where nothing is discussed save clothes."

FREE SWIMMING POOL OWNED BY MUNICIPALITY

ORDINANCE NO. 766

An ordinance declaring the cost of the improvement for the paving of West Eleventh street from Peach street to Hamilton street, and assessing the property benefited thereby, and declaring such assessment, and directing the entry thereof in the docket of city liens.

The City of Medford doth ordain as follows:

Section 1. Whereas, protests against the improvement by paving of West Eleventh street from Peach street to Hamilton street have been duly considered and due notice of the intention of the council to cause said improvement to be made, having been given, and said improvement having been ordered made, the council has considered the matter, and herewith incants the cost of making such improvement to be the sum of \$258.33.

And, whereas, said council further finds that the special and peculiar benefit accruing upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement and in just proportion to benefits derived to be the respective amounts hereinafter set opposite the number or description of each lot or part thereof, and such amounts respectively are hereby declared to be the proportionate share of each lot or part thereof of the cost of such improvement, and is hereby declared to be assessed against said lot or parcels respectively, the name appearing above each description being the name of the owner or reputed owner of each lot or parcel.

Section 2. The recorder of the city of Medford is hereby directed to enter a statement of the assessments hereby made in the docket of city liens, and to give notice by publication, as required by the charter and ordinance No. 713, in a newspaper published and of general circulation in said city.
