# PHONE COMPANY RATES ON PHONES FOURTEEN MINERS

SALEM, Ore., July 23. - Establishing a precedent that may have far reaching effect, the state railroad commission today issued an order brought to Portland by Freddie An- a local engagement at the Page to- directing the Eastern Oregon cooperative telephone company in Union county to increase its rates more than double as a matter of selfpreservation for itself and fair dealing toward its competitor which alleges it cannot continue to exist in competition with former rates.

In this case the Home Independent Telephone company complained that the Eastern Oregon company was ruining its business by its low competitive rates and that it was securing the cream of the husiness in Union county, and that it was operating its lines, which served Elgin, Summerville, Cove and Union at a loss to it-

The company was furnishing teleshones to its own members, who paid

a membership fee of \$35, for fifty cents a monuth, and to non-members for \$1.00 a month. Later these rates were adjusted so that both nembers and non-members paid \$1.00 a month for service. The co-operative company's officials declare they
