SAN FRANCISCO, Cal., Sept. 20. News of the arrest at El Paso of George Orrin Poole, also known as "Snake" Poole, and George Moore, on a charge of emplicity in a big opium smuggling plot, was received by the federal authorities here to-

Poole was caught by a United States treasury agent last night, it was stated, while trying to cross into Mexico. Thomas Murphy and Chinese, Chung Chow, already were in custody here, charged with complicity in the same case, but another alleged member of the gang, said to he named Benton, is still at large.

The authorities assert most of the opium snuggling into the United States is managed by Poole and that he has grown rich on the traffic.
