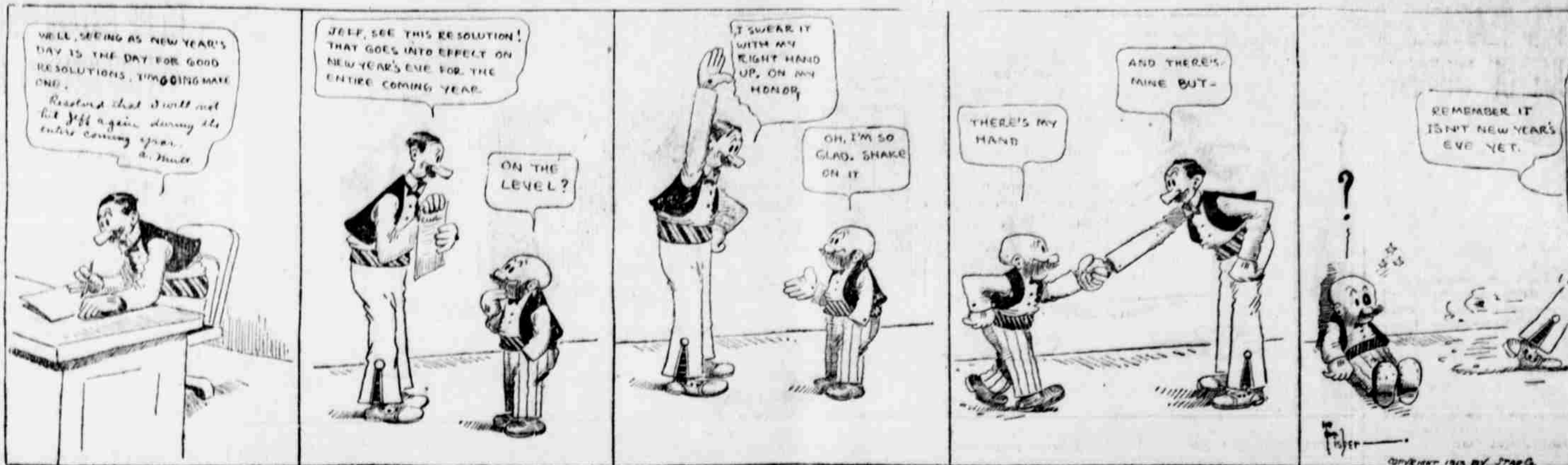

SOCIAL HYGIENE TO AID SEX INSTRUCTION

The Oregon Social Hygiene Society of Portland, Oregon, is anxious to give Medford and southern Oregon the benefit of their organization which is doing a great service to the state and country in its campaign for enlightenment on sex facts. LULL IN FIGHTING IN ATTACK ON OJINAGA

PRESIDIO, Tex., Jan. 6.—Though there was a lull today in fighting at Ojinaga, it seemed unlikely to be a long one.

General Herrera, with 3000 rebels, was marching from Chihuahua City to aid in the attack on the town. Simultaneously, General Arguedo, with 4000 federals, was coming from Torreon to help the garrison.

The two bodies were racing for La Mala pass, the key to Ojinaga, and whichever one reached it first, it would possess an enormous strategic advantage. The chances seemed to favor Arguedo. His force was mostly cavalry. Herrera, hampered by a wagon train and artillery, was said to be making slow time.

ASHLAND FRUIT EXCHANGE HALDS ANNUAL MEETING

The Ashland Fruit and Produce Association held its annual meeting Saturday and reported a profitable business the past year. C. H. WHISLER BOX BILL IS INTRODUCED IN CONGRESS

The first fruit box bill drawn up by the fruit growers of the northwest has been presented in the house of representatives by John E. Baker of California entitled H. R. 11,178 and has been referred to the committee on interstate and foreign commerce. C. E. Whisler was the author of the bill and the measure has had the unanimous endorsement of all the fruit organizations of the Pacific coast in addition to numerous personal endorsements. Mr. Whisler in recognition of his services has been delegated by the fruit growers of Montana, Idaho, Oregon and Washington to meet the committee when the bill comes up, probably the first of next month.

OBITUARY.

Oregon loses another of its pioneers with the death of Mrs. Martha M. Brown at Brownsboro.

Mrs. Brown was born at Buffalo, N. Y., June 2, 1829. The family removed to Lake Geneva, Wis., where she was married to Henry R. Brown in 1849. Leaving the comfortable parental home, she and her husband set forth to brave the perils and hardships of pioneer life, crossing the plains in one of those famous trains of "prairie schooners" which brought so many of our forefathers and mothers across the great American desert to the homestead in the wilderness.

They settled at Brownsboro, a small town which Mr. Brown had previously founded. Here their children were born, three daughters, Mrs. L. C. Charley, Mrs. Mary Terrill, Mrs. Emogene Charley, and one son, George B. Brown, all still living near Brownsboro.

Mrs. Brown was a woman of sincere Christian belief, whose loving heart always pleaded for peace and fairness; a woman to whom those in trouble instinctively turned for sympathy and advice as one whom they trusted and on whom they depended; a woman of strong character such as Oregon needed in a pioneer mother. She leaves a wide circle of relatives and friends to mourn her loss. Mrs. Brown had been ill for several weeks, and on December 23, 1913, she answered the call, and met her savior, face to face.
