Operations of an alleged desperate Black Hand gang which, the police believe, deserted Lohman after he had thrown a bomb into the plant at Lyndhurst, N. J., of Klee & Co., were laid bare.

REVOLUTION IN HAITI GROWS MORE SERIOUS

CAPE HAITIEN, Haiti, Jan. 27.—The revolutionary movement in Haiti is spreading with alarming rapidity. Reports received here today said the entire population of Port de Paix and Gonaives had risen. General Carlos Zamor and General Beaufosse La Roche, two prominent exiles and former ministers of war, returned today to Cape Haitien, which is in the hands of the rebels.

CIVIL GOVERNMENT IN PANAMA ZONE

WASHINGTON, Jan. 27.—President Wilson issued this afternoon a formal executive order establishing civil government on the Panama canal zone. The naming of Colonel George W. Goethals as governor of the zone was expected to follow soon.

DANGER OF FLOOD SACRAMENTO PASSES

CRISIS TONIGHT FLOOD SITUATION IN SAN JOAQUIN

STOCKTON, Cal., Jan. 27.—The delta reclamations of the lower San Joaquin will pass through a crisis tonight and tomorrow. This morning at 8 o'clock the San Joaquin river here reached a height of 19.5 feet at Lathrop and was still rising slowly. The danger mark is 18 feet, and the highest stage ever known was recorded in February, 1911, when the river reached 22.5 feet, and the deltas became an inland sea.
