PENDLETON FACES WARFARE AFTER EVANGELIST'S VISIT PENDLETON, Ore., March 4.—At a mass meeting last night the Rev. J. Bulgis announced before 2500 persons in the tabernacle that he had consulted over the telephone with Miss Fern Hobbs in Governor West's office in Salem and that she had assured the Law and Order League of Pendleton that if the local officers do not immediately act upon the charges of alleged official graft in gambling, prostitution and liquor violations, state troops will be sent here and the city declared under martial law until the conditions are cleaned up.
