part in the struggle on the floor. Before the house met the rules committee reported out an amended rule for consideration of the repeal bill. It provided that the debate should be limited to 20 hours and the time divided as follows:

To Representative Adamson for the repeal of the exemption clause, ten hours. To Representative Knowlton and others five hours, Doremus and other democrats opposed to repeal one hour.

Every indication pointed to the debate on the repeal bill being extremely bitter.

Filibuster Started Representative Fitzgerald's insistence for imminent consideration of the urgent deficiency bill was regarded as savoring of a filibuster. The bill, as it now stands, provides \$200,000 for the care of interned Mexican federalists at Fort Bliss, Texas.

Representative Mann attacked the appropriation and insisted that the house ought to know just how long the Mexicans had been in the government's care. He said their care was now costing about \$2,000,000 annually.

Democrats argued that it would be inhuman to turn Mexican refugees back.

Just as a final vote on the rivers and harbors bill appeared imminent Representative Humphrey started a filibuster by demanding rollcalls. It was figured this would delay consideration of the repeal resolution until 4 o'clock.

PORTLAND COUPLE UNDER INDICTMENT

PORTLAND, Ore., Mar. 26.—Indictments were returned today by the grand jury against Earl Carl, alias John R. Ainsley, and his wife, who went under the name of Emma A. Brown, charging each with obtaining money and property under false pretenses. A couple, whom the police here claim are the persons indicted, are under arrest at Los Angeles.

The indictments charge that Carl passed a check for \$25.50 and Mrs. Carl one for \$20 when they knew they had a balance of but \$3.35 in the Scandinavian Bank here, and had checks aggregating \$535 outstanding against that slender balance.

orchards have sufficient supply to last over another night, but as there are no storage tanks here, except those on the orchards, a protracted frost period easily exhausts the supply. As a result, a concerted effort will be made to induce the Standard Oil company to erect storage tanks here to avoid future fuel famines.

The quantity of oil burned is shown by the fact that A. C. Allen alone burned 6000 gallons at Holly orchard and that 4000 pots were consumed at 401 orchard. Other orchards burned in proportion.

Observer Arrives Clyde Barnum again volunteered as weather observer Wednesday night and predicted a temperature of 21 before morning. Ben C. Sheldon assisted him throughout the night, phoning orchardists and assisting them with suggestions and information.
